BULLETIN - PARC FERME FUEL ARRANGEMENT UAE RMC R4

Dear Competitors/Entrants,

We will be trialing a new arrangement for the management of race fuel at UAE RMC Round 4 which we hope will streamline fuel preparation, storage and distribution for the benefit of all parties.

PROCEDURE

Competitors/mechanics (with their respective ID badge) should present their race fuel tank to the organisation according to the time window detailed on the official schedule.

The fuel tank must have the race number clearly and indelibly marked on it along with a clear and obvious line to mark the amount of fuel required for Qualifying. Fuel tanks must be in good condition, free from leaks and with caps/covers on all inlets/outlets/breathers.

The fuel tank will be filled to the line by the organisation under the supervision of the driver/mechanic and then stored in a controlled area, to be made available for collection at the entry service area ahead of the respective Qualifying session.

At the end of each on-track session, competitors/mechanics will be able to add fuel to the tank in preparation for the next race and return it to the fuel control area **BEFORE** leaving Parc Ferme.

Please note that the refueling station will only be accessible inside the exit service park (Parc Ferme) so fuel cannot be added at the start service area.

The above process will continue throughout the event. After the Day 1 Final (Sat 17th Jan) competitors must ensure that the fuel tank is filled to the correct level for Day 2 Qualifying.

It is anticipated that, ultimately, we may be able to remove the requirement for competitors to supply their own 20 litre jerry cans ahead of race events. However, competitors must ensure that they have jerry cans available at this event in case needed as a contingency.

This Bulletin supersedes the information contained in the event Supplementary Regulations.

We are happy to receive feedback on the new arrangement during/after the event in order to evaluate future fuel preparation and handling.
