Digital Licence Penalty Points

Applicable to: All Competitors and Entrants

Competitors are reminded that Motorsport UK Karting operates a digital licence penalty points system for the British Kart Championships. Penalty points may be applied by the Stewards of the Event for certain breaches in accordance with the relevant regulations and mandatory karting penalties.

Relevant Breaches

- **Ch.2 Annexe A Art.1.5** - Gaining an unfair advantage - 1 point per breach
- **Ch.18 App.7 Art.2.5(e)** - Crowding - 2 to 3 points per breach
- **Ch.18 App.7 Art.2.8** - Causing a collision - 2 to 3 points per breach
- **Ch.2 App.1 Art.1.13** - Driving in a manner incompatible with general safety - 3 to 6 points per breach
- **Ch.2.App.1 Art.1.16** - Misbehaviour, Unfair Practice Reprimand 1 point

Application of Penalty Points

Penalty points are recorded against the driver's digital BKC driver record and do not affect the driver's Motorsport UK competition licence.

Penalty points accumulate during the Championship season. These will be noted on the decision sheet.

Drivers/teams reaching a total of 12 penalty points will result in an automatic referral to the Championship Stewards and an automatic 10 Championship point deduction for the driver or team.

Following the application of that Championship point deduction, the penalty points are removed from the driver's digital record.

Purpose

The purpose of this system is to support fair, safe and transparent competition, and to deter repeated driving standard offences across the Championship.

Competitors and Entrants are reminded to ensure they are familiar with the relevant regulations and the consequences of repeat breaches.

Penalty points are not eligible for appeal.
